



Region 14 ESC Safety Audit Report Summary

In September 2011, trained safety auditors conducted an on-site visit at the DeLeon Elementary, DeLeon Middle School, DeLeon High School in DeLeon ISD for the purpose of a security/safety audit. The purpose of this service is to assist you in maintaining a proactive approach to Safe and Drug Free Schools for all students and staff and satisfies the requirement by Senate Bill 11 and *TEC §37.108* for a safety audit once every three years.

The following areas were included in the Region 14 ESC Safety Audit Process:

 - Electrical Issues
 - Fire Safety

 - First Aid Capacity

- Health and Wellness Factors
- Grounds and Building Exterior
- Outlying Buildings
- Playground Safety
- Science Labs
- Vocational Education Labs (Auto Tech, Ag, Building Trades, Cosmetology, etc.)
- Critical Documents
- Emergency Operations Plans/Procedures/Drills

A brief review of the findings on each campus was verbally reported to the principal at the conclusion of each site visit. Detailed written reports of the findings and recommendations were given to Ray Crass on September 19, 2011.
